MAXIMUM LEVEL OF BENEFITS (effective 24 February 2011)

1. Subsection 31(7) of the *Seafarers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1992* provides for a ceiling on weekly incapacity payments after the first 45 weeks.
2. This ceiling is 150% of the Average Weekly Ordinary Time Earnings for Full Time Adults (AWOTEFA). The AWOTEFA is published quarterly by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS).
3. The latest published AWOTEFA figure (November Quarter 2010) is \$1,272.50:

Date of Effect	AWOTEFA	150% of AWOTEFA
24 February 2011	\$1,272.50	\$ 1,908.75

4. Calculation of entitlements under subsection 31(7) should be made using the above amount.
5. The next AWOTEFA update is expected to be released on 19 May 2011.
