**NOTICE NO 05/2001**

**CHANGE TO MILEAGE RATE**

Subsections 28(6A)(b), 49(6B)(b), 50(2B)(b), 66(4B) and 83A(5) of the *Seafarers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1992* provide the Minister with the power to specify a rate per kilometre for journeys appropriate to the subsections indicated above.

On 25 June 2001, the Minister for Employment, Workplace Relations and Small Business, Tony Abbott MP specified in Notice No 1 of 2001 the rate of 42 cents per kilometre in respect of any journey to which the above subsections apply.

The rate of 42 cents came into effect on and from **1 July 2001**, being the date specified in the Notice. Any payments made under the above subsections since 1 July 2001 are to be adjusted using the increased rate specified in this notice.
