AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES**

**NOTICE NO 03/2006**

**MAXIMUM LEVEL OF BENEFITS**

1. Subsection 31(7) of the *Seafarers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1992* provides for a ceiling on weekly incapacity payments after the first 45 weeks.
2. This ceiling is 150% of the Average Weekly Ordinary Time Earnings for Full Time Adults (AWOTEFA). The AWOTEFA is published quarterly by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.
3. The updated AWOTEFA figure is:

<b>Date of Effect</b>	<b>AWOTEFA</b>	<b>150% of AWOTEFA</b>
23 February 2006	\$1,029.50	\$1,544.25

4. The next AWOTEFA update is expected in May 2006.
5. Calculation of entitlements under subsection 31(7) should be made using the above amount.
