



**NOTICE TO MARITIME INDUSTRY ORGANISATIONS  
AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES**

**NOTICE NO 1/2000**

**MAXIMUM LEVEL OF BENEFITS**

Subsection 31(7) of the *Seafarers Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 1992* provides that the maximum amount of weekly compensation payable after the first 45 weeks of incapacity is 150% of the Average Weekly Ordinary Time Earnings of Full-time Adults (AWOTEFA), as published from time to time by the Australian Statistician.

The AWOTEFA amount (issued by the Australian Bureau of Statistics on 2 March 2000 – catalogue number 6302.0) is \$763.20.

Accordingly, from that date the maximum amount of weekly compensation payable after 45 weeks incapacity is \$1144.80 (150% x \$763.20).
